

Ox Ranch Airport (01TX) Permit & Liability Waiver

A current completed copy of this Airport Permit and Waiver of Liability must be on file with the ranch lodge before you land at Ox Ranch Airport (01TX). Aircraft using the Ox Ranch Airport must have/carry a minimum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for piston powered aircraft and Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) for turbine powered aircraft.

Liability Insurance In consideration of being permitted to use the airport, each airport user agrees that neither OX RANCH INVESTMENT LLC (“Ox Hunting Ranch”) nor its officers, directors, agents, employees and members shall, at any time or to any extent whatsoever, be liable, responsible or in any way accountable for any loss, injury, death or damage to persons or property which at any time may be suffered or sustained by any person whomsoever arising out of the use or occupancy of the airport or its facilities. Each airport user also agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Ox Hunting Ranch and its officers, directors, agents, employees and members free and harmless from and against any and all claims, liability, loss, damage or expense whatsoever, including attorney’s fees, arising out of or resulting from any use of the airport or any portion thereof by said airport user, his passengers, guests, invitees, agents or employees and said airport user waives all claims against Ox Hunting Ranch, and its officers, directors, agents, employees and members for any death or bodily injury and damage to aircraft or other personal property on or about the airport or any portion thereof from any cause or reason whatsoever. Each airport user specifically waives any claim against Ox Hunting Ranch and its officers, directors, agents, employees and members as a result of the negligent design, inspection, repair and maintenance of the airport including, but not limited to, its runway, taxi way, tie downs and hangars.

Ox Ranch Airport (01TX) Brief

Ox Ranch Airport is a private airport and requires prior approval for landing. A completed Airport Permit form must be on file with the Ox Hunting Ranch before landing at the airport. Runway 17/35 is approximately 5800 feet long and 70 feet wide. The runway is approximately 1,300 feet above MSL and is located in a valley 35 NMs northwest of Rocksprings (RSG) VOR on the 154 Radial. Your GPS can find us at 29°27'42.97"N 100° 6'51.49"W. A windsock is located halfway down the runway. Fuel is not available on the airfield.

Communications Airport users are required to broadcast position reports and intentions on CTAF 122.800 upon approaching the airport, entering downwind, base, final approach, and occupying the runway.

Operations Landings and takeoffs for turbine powered aircraft will be permitted only during the period beginning 30 minutes before sunrise and ending 30 minutes after sunset each day, except under emergency conditions. **Turbine powered aircraft are NOT authorized for night operations unless prior permission is received in writing.** Aircraft are to be parked at the approach end of runway 17 in the turnaround circle. Please park to the side as much as possible. **LANDING IS NOT PERMITTED IF AN AIRCRAFT IS OCCUPYING THE RUNWAY, EVEN IF PARKED IN TURN AROUND CIRCLE.** It is the responsibility of the pilot in command and the aircraft owner to ensure the runway and it's attached surfaces are not occupied by any aircraft, vehicles or objects.

Alternate Procedures If unable to land at 01TX, please proceed to KUVA Uvalde Garner Field Municipal Airport. For aircraft unable to land at Uvalde, the next closest airfield is KDRT Del Rio International Airport. For aircraft arriving from outside the United States, the closest customs location is KDRT.

Traffic Pattern Altitudes Traffic patterns and altitudes for aircraft operations at the airport are as follows:

- Piston aircraft – 2,300 ft. MSL
- Turbine engine powered aircraft – 3,300 ft. MSL
- Helicopters – 2,300 ft. MSL

Traffic Patterns Runway 17 is into the prevailing wind and is the preferred runway for all landing and takeoffs. Runway 17 is the runway to use when the winds are calm. **Left traffic runway 17, right traffic runway 35.**

While this document provides for approval to operate at 01TX, please call prior to departure to verify your arrival to the ranch to ensure transportation will be standing by.

I agree that I have read and will comply with the 01TX Airport Brief, will not operate a turbine powered aircraft at night and my aircrafts wingspan is no greater than 70' wide.

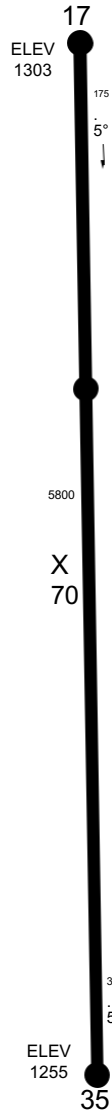
